**PROVISION OF AMBULANCE TRANSPORT**

Consent to a person to:

- a) directly or indirectly provide or take part in the provision of transport for sick or injured persons for fee or reward.
  
- b) conduct for fee or reward any operations similar to the operations carried on by the Health Secretary under Chapter 5A of the Health Services Act 1997.

Impose conditions on the consent, revoke any consent given or revoke or vary any condition imposed.

---

**PROCEDURE**

It is an offence for a person to provide transport of sick or injured persons for fee or reward, or conduct for fee or reward any operations similar to the operations carried on by the Health Secretary under Chapter 5A of the Health Services Act, without the consent of the Health Secretary.
