Role Delineation of Health Services

Role delineation has been applied in NSW to inform strategic service, clinical and capital planning at the local and State level since the mid-1980s. The NSW Health *Guide to the Role Delineation of Clinical Services 2019* (the Guide) is a planning tool that provides a framework to describe the minimum support services, workforce and other requirements for clinical services to be delivered safely. It delineates the level of clinical services, not hospitals or health facilities as a whole.

Service planners within Local Health Districts (districts) and Specialty Health Networks (networks) use the Guide as a tool when developing clinical services plans, business cases for capital projects and other service planning activities. Districts and networks are responsible for determining the appropriate role delineation level of services at their facilities.

This document provides a snapshot of the role delineation levels for a number of emergency medicine services in NSW public hospitals. Information within this publication may not be comparable to the *Role Delineation Levels of Emergency Medicine (2014)*, which was based on the *Guide to the Role Delineation of Health Services Third Edition 2002*.

Review of this information will occur on an annual basis, unless there has been a major commissioning of services.
