## No smoking at public transport stops and stations

From 7 January 2013, there are new requirements in NSW making the following areas smoke-free.



**Platforms of** passenger railways and light rail stations.



Bus stops.



Ferry wharves.



Light rail stops.



Taxi ranks.

The ban applies to covered and uncovered areas, and includes the area where people queue or gather.

## Penalties may apply for anyone who fails to comply with the new laws.

These amendments to the Smoke-free Environment Act 2000 are a key measure in reducing community exposure to second-hand tobacco smoke, tobacco-related harm and the uptake of smoking in NSW.
