• Each patient will have a clinical pathway planned and presented to them and their family. For elective patients this will happen in pre admission, and for emergency patients as soon as the pathway is clear.



# How will **SURGERY** monitor our commitment to Principle Six?



### PRINCIPLE 6

Patients will be actively managed to ensure they are only in hospital for as long as is clinically necessary.

- Discharge planning will begin with the discussion of the clinical pathway and where necessary early involvement of Hospital in the Home, allied health and rehabilitation will be activated
- The afternoon "board round" will be used to monitor compliance and modify as necessary



## What actions will **SURGERY** take to ensure our commitment is sustained?



#### PRINCIPLE 6

Patients will be actively managed to ensure they are only in hospital for as long as is clinically necessary.

- Discharge summaries, medications and any referrals not in progress will be completed the day before planned discharge.
- Any significant deviation from the clinical pathway will trigger a unit review/discussion including the whole management team to reassess the progress as a formal team meeting, repeated as necessary, until the pathway has bee re-established.

### Supply Chain Management in patient care.
