Aboriginal Health Worker and Aboriginal Health Practitioner Forum 2021

The 2021 forum will explore the theme of Culturally Centred Care. This includes what it looks like and feels like for Aboriginal patients to receive culturally centred care, and how to support Aboriginal staff who are essential to providing this service.

In 2021 the Forum will be held on Mondays 9, 16, 23 and Wednesday 25 August. This timing was chosen to align with the NAATSIHWP National Recognition Day for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Health Workers and Practitioners. It will be a wholly online event to accommodate COVID-19 pandemic travel restrictions and increase access for more people to attend.

A working group was formed in early 2021 who decided on an overarching theme of “Culturally Centred Care” to explore issues and opportunities facing Aboriginal staff who support the cultural responsiveness of NSW Health to engage with Aboriginal people and their family and carers.
