

BMDH Project Stage 1

- \$300M+ Expansion
- Two hospital sites
- 180 additional beds
- New cancer, cardiology, respiratory, & aged care centres
- Mental Health
- Completed April 2016



BMDH Project Stage 2

- \$400M+ expansion
- Emergency, theatres, ICU
- Birthing, maternity, newborn, women's health
- Paediatrics
- Dialysis, drug health, MRI, theatres
- Complete 2020








Arts projects
