

Approval of an organisation to issue an emergency asthma management certificate

Clause 18(3) of the *Poisons and Therapeutic Goods Regulation 2008*

I, Bruce Battye, Acting Chief Pharmacist and delegate of the Health Secretary, for the purposes of clause 18(3) of the *Poisons and Therapeutic Goods Regulation 2008* (NSW), do hereby:

1. Revoke the approval instrument signed 19 December 2019 and annexed to this instrument; and
2. Approve an organisation listed in Column A of the Schedule below to issue an emergency asthma management certificate to a person in relation to possession and use of salbutamol or terbutaline in metered aerosols if required in connection with the carrying out of first aid, subject to the condition in the corresponding row in Column B of the Schedule.

In this instrument:

- *Registered Training Organisation* has the same meaning as in the *National Vocational Education and Training Regulator Act 2011* (Cth).
- *Office of Sport and Department of Education* have the same meaning as in the *Government Sector Employment Act 2013*.

This approval instrument commences on signature and remains in effect until revoked.


