


POISONS AND THERAPEUTIC GOODS REGULATION 2008

EXEMPTION

I, BRUCE BATTYE, A/g Chief Pharmacist and a duly appointed delegate of the Secretary of the Ministry of Health, pursuant to clauses 10, 28, and 72 of the *Poisons and Therapeutic Goods Regulation 2008 (the Regulation)*, do hereby exempt:

- an authorised practitioner from the packaging and labelling requirements at clauses 7(2); 26(2); and 69(2) of the Regulation, but only in relation to:
 - Appendix A[5](3) of the Regulation, namely the requirement for a warning to be immediately preceded by a symbol in the form of an open equilateral triangle at least 4.5 millimetres high in bold print, coloured red; and
 - Appendix A[3] of the Regulation, limited to the requirement for the warning to be immediately preceded by a symbol in the form of an open equilateral triangle at least 4.5 millimetres high in bold print, coloured red.
- a pharmacist from the packaging and labelling requirements at clauses 7(3); 26(3); and 69(3) of the Regulation, but only in relation to:
 - Appendix A[5](3) of the Regulation, namely the requirement for a warning to be immediately preceded by a symbol in the form of an open equilateral triangle at least 4.5 millimetres high in bold print, coloured red; and
 - Appendix A[3] of the Regulation, limited to the requirement for the warning to be immediately preceded by a symbol in the form of an open equilateral triangle at least 4.5 millimetres high in bold print, coloured red.

Note: *The effect of this instrument is to exempt authorised practitioners and pharmacists from any requirement to package and label the following substances with a symbol in the form of a red, bold, equilateral triangle at least 4.5 millimetres high:*

- *scheduled substances specified in Appendix K to the national Poisons Standard*
- *amphetamine*
- *chlorphentermine*
- *dexamphetamine (dexamphetamine)*
- *diethylpropion*
- *ephedrine*
- *lisdexamfetamine*
- *methylphenidate*
- *phentermine; and*
- *propylhexedrine.*
