EBI Program Mandate

The EDWARD Business Implementation (EBI) Program is mandated to provide a baseline of ***standard operationally focussed reports*** for NSW Health Local Health Districts (LHDs) to aid LHDs in running their business by providing a single source of truth across all of NSW Health around ***performance information*** for Wait List (WL), Emergency Department (ED) and Operating Theatre....

....when it is needed, in the format it is needed in, and in a quality, accurate manner.

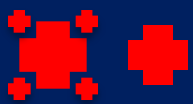
